- 4. **CGL Planter outside Richmond House**: Update on clearing and planting the main planter outside Richmond House by local and Good Gym volunteers on Saturday, November 8, at 10 AM. Sian Berry may join.
- 5. **Round Hill Society historic records**: Discussion regarding Robert Stephenson's inquiry about recycling 20 years plus of RHS activity minutes, reports, and other documents. Suggest taking to the Keep.
- 6. **Neighbourhood Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)**: Discussion on potential infrastructure improvement projects for Round Hill, as approximately £22,000 is available for the ward through the new Neighbourhood CIL.
