### Notes

- Approval of AGM Minutes: Check on the minutes from the Annual General Meeting (AGM).
  - Stefania will provide for next time.
- Upcoming in June Round Hill Open Gardens, South and South East in Bloom, Brighton & Hove Community Garden Network Open Days & Trail.
  - Proposal submitted and received 4th highest positive comments out of ~900 submissions
  - Focused on nature improvement corridor from Sylvan Hall along Richmond Road and parallel to the historic laundry drying gardens
  - Incorporated trees, birds, and pollinators based on stakeholder input
  - GDPR concerns raised about public visibility of commenter names on council website
  - Complained to council about councillors submitting their own proposals while judging others
  - Next phase: Council evaluation for feasibility (1 month), then public voting from 9 February
  - Positive feedback from CPRE Sussex and tree officer Jen Eneke
  - Two groups approached about pocket parks: Helen (Ladysmith Road) and Veryan (Kemptown planters)
  - Across June: Community garden network trail – funding application for trail map submitted to B&H Buses
  - Trying to get all the garden events to coincide so that the RH is framed in the best light for the S&SE In Bloom competition
- Planning application request that has come through from Richmond Road.
  - Richmond Road planning application requires review by 21st January deadline
  - Minor front modifications: PVC heritage-style windows, loft windows
  - Rear dormer addition raises potential conservation area concerns
  - Need Michael's guidance on society's position
- Update on Veolia at Hollingdean.
  - Waiting for Cllr Tim Rowkins to come back with more info
  - Local democracy reporter, Sarah Booker-Lewis, writing an article.
- Upcoming events.
  - June 2025 coordination planned:
    - Round Hill open gardens
    - Brighton Hove Community Garden Network trail
    - South & Southeast in Bloom competition
  - Street play scheduled for May 2025

- Plant sale component to fund community planters
  - Need handover meeting with Laura Kate
  - Food waste bins rollout by March 2025 (statutory deadline)
- Reporter.
  - Promote street play in May, Gardens in June
  - Write an article about recycling remind people of what they can and can't recycle, along with food waste bin update
- Any Other Business (AOB).
  - Request from Upper Lewes Road to discuss road safety - how to respond
    - Council prioritises traffic flow over safety measures
    - Assessment system requires accidents/deaths for priority ranking
    - Previous Round Hill assessments ranked 39-40 out of 100, so low-priority relative to other spots in the city
    - Air quality issues: Brighton among UK's most polluted cities (January 2024)
    - Round Hill on edge of "red zone" for nitrous oxide levels
  - Andrea's gardening tools now in the tool shed behind the CGL building; his plants collected for putting in community planters in spring.
    - Italian gardener Andrea donated £200+ worth of tools and plants before returning to Italy
    - Equipment stored in CDL community shed
    - Additional plants available at his allotment until 10th January
    - Proposed and agreed £100 payment to Andrea's GoFundMe for donated materials (taken from greening budget)
  - Carol singing money raised - Dominic following up with Rachel

- Chris to submit a safety assessment request for Upper Lewes Road re: road safety
- Dominic to give Gary Andrea's bank details
- Emmanuel to get the Reporter started
- Stefania to send round minutes of AGM
