# Round Hill Neighbourhood Forum Constitution

#### 1. Name

The name of the forum shall be: Round Hill Neighbourhood Forum.

## 2. Purpose

The purpose of the forum is to:

- Promote or improve the social, economic, and environmental well-being of the Round Hill neighbourhood area.
- Prepare a Neighbourhood Development Plan in accordance with the Localism Act 2011 and associated regulations.
- Encourage inclusive community involvement in planning decisions affecting the area.

# 3. Neighbourhood Area

The forum shall relate to the area known as Round Hill in Brighton, UK. A map of the proposed area is attached to this constitution (as Appendix A).

## 4. Membership

- Membership is open to individuals who:
- Live in the Round Hill neighbourhood area,
- Work there (including business owners), or
- Are elected members of a local authority representing the area.
- The forum must have a minimum of 21 members drawn from a mix of these groups.
- The membership should reflect the diversity and character of the area.

#### 5. Forum Structure and Roles

- a. Chairperson
- Elected by the members.
- Leads meetings, represents the forum, and liaises with the local authority.

## b. Secretary

- Maintains records, correspondence, and organises meetings and documentation.
- c. Treasurer
- Manages finances, including grants, and keeps accurate financial records.
- d. Community Engagement Officer (optional but recommended)
- Leads on community outreach, consultations, and communication strategies.
- e. Planning/Technical Lead (optional)
- Provides or coordinates planning expertise; assists in drafting and technical tasks.
- f. Working Groups (optional)

- Topic-based subgroups (e.g. housing, environment) led by forum members.

All officers shall be elected annually at the AGM.

## 6. Meetings

- The forum shall meet at least 4 times per year.
- An Annual General Meeting (AGM) shall be held once per calendar year.
- Decisions shall be made by majority vote of those present.

## 7. Quorum

A quorum for general meetings shall be 25% of members or 10 members, whichever is greater.

#### 8. Finance

- The forum may apply for and manage funds, including government or charitable grants.
- The Treasurer shall present a financial report at each AGM.

# 9. Decision-Making

All major decisions, including those related to the neighbourhood plan, must be agreed by a majority vote of forum members.

## 10. Amendments to the Constitution

Amendments may be made at the AGM or a special meeting with at least 14 days' notice and a majority vote of two-thirds of members present.

## 11. Dissolution

- The forum may be dissolved by a vote of two-thirds of members.
- Any assets shall be transferred to a community or charitable organisation with similar objectives.

## 12. Declaration

We, the undersigned, support the formation of the Round Hill Neighbourhood Forum and agree to abide by the terms of this constitution.
