Monthly Maintenance Schedule

January

- Minimal activity.
- Check for wind damage or frost heaving.
- Light tidy of fallen debris.
- Cut back **Sedum Autumn Joy** if not already done.

February

- Begin light pruning:
 - O Sarcococca ruscifolia: Tidy/prune after flowering.

March

- Cut back:
 - O **Penstemon**: Remove old stems to new growth.
 - Aster, Echinops, Verbena, Geranium, Sedum: Clear dead stems to make way for new shoots.
- Light prune **Erysimum Bowles Mauve** (do not cut into woody stems).
- Weed and tidy.

April

- General weeding.
- Light shaping of Hebe Black Beauty.
- Watch for early aphids on soft new growth.

May

- Begin deadheading spent blooms (especially Erysimum, Penstemon, Geranium).
- Stake tall perennials like **Verbena** and **Aster** if needed.
- Water in dry periods.
- Inspect for mildew on Verbena and Aster.

June

Continue deadheading and weeding.

- Light trim of **Lavenders** (white and purple) after flowering starts fading.
- Monitor water needs closely.
- Remove any suckers or crowding.

July

- Tidy foliage, deadhead.
- Light summer tidy of **Convolvulus cneorum** if needed.
- Check supports on taller plants.
- Trim **Hebe** lightly if necessary.

August

- Keep deadheading and removing tired foliage.
- **Cut back Lavender** once flowering is done (don't cut into old wood).
- Water if prolonged dry spell.
- Check plant health summer stress may reveal issues.

September

- Continue cutting back faded growth.
- Light pruning of **Erysimum**.
- Divide and replant **Geranium Rozanne** if overgrown.

October

• Begin tidying for winter:

November

- Final structural tidy.
- Check for drainage issues ahead of wet season.
- Prune back **Penstemon** lightly (leave base growth for winter protection).
- Secure any loose plants or stakes.

December

- Rest.
- Monitor for wind/water damage.

Hebe Black Beauty

Dark purple foliage and pink flowers. Evergreen and compact



Lavender white



Penstemon digitalis 'Husker Red'

Dark red foliage with white tubular flowers. Attracts bees.



Aster 'Monch'Lavender-blue daisy flowers late summer to autumn. Bee-friendly.



Geranium Rozanne (rug type)

Sprawling habit, same violet flowers as 'Rozanne'. Great for carpeting.



Convolvulus cneorum

Silvery foliage and white trumpet flowers. Drought-tolerant.



Verbena bonariensis

Tall stems with airy purple flower clusters. Long bloom season.



Sarcococca ruscifolia

Glossy evergreen shrub with fragrant winter flowers and red berries.



Lavender purple

Aromatic purple blooms and grey-green foliage; full sun and dry soil.



Erysimum 'Bowles's Mauve'
Long-flowering perennial with mauve flowers; attracts pollinators.



Echinops ritro 'Platinum Blue'

Spiky, metallic-blue globe flowers. Loved by bees.



Sedum 'Autumn Joy' Fleshy leaves and flat pink flower heads that age to rust red.
